Suggested wording for your will

I give % of my residuary estate OR I give the sum of £_____ (pounds only) free of all taxes to the District Church Council of All Saints in the parish of Whitstable in the Diocese of Canterbury for the sole and general purposes of All Saints church, and I declare that the receipt of an officer of the District Church Council shall be a sufficient discharge to my executors and trustees.
